Bible Society news from their magazine "Word in Action." I have selected two pieces of news to share with you.

EGYPT: is not a majority Christian country. The population is 111 million. Christian 15 million.

The Bible Society provided 115,000 Bibles and New Testaments in 2023 and continues to do so. They are passed to Church Leaders and usually given away to those who are eager to read and study them. This will bring new life in the midst of poverty. Over 500 Study leaders are being trained to lead groups that will attract young people and others to transform their lives.

IRAN: The government prevents the printing and distribution of Christian resources in their national language, FARSI. It is a criminal offence to convert from Islam to Christianity.

We give thanks that a church in South West England has used "Charity Welcome Churches" to care for Asylum seekers. Their success is such that two-thirds of the congregation are now Iranian. The CWC partnership with the Bible Society now involves 1300 congregations who seek to see that every refugee is welcomed by a church.

This is all very encouraging. I will be sending our Church contribution to the Bible Society very soon. (You may wish to help.) (Sorry no Coffee Morning)
